Innovative Product of the Year Award

- Is based within the UK
- Demonstrates Tomorrow's Healthcare's values of trying to achieve sustainability, social value and future thinking in all that they do
- Details of the product innovation, how it was developed, its goals and ethos and how a need was identified for the product
- Evidence and effectiveness of the product and the verifiable reductions to the environment or positive impacts to society
- Awareness raising to promote and support the environmental and/or social benefits of the product incl. market reaction, public and sector engagement, industry awards won, press coverage gained
- The wider potential for scalability and replicability.
